This is the first ride of the year so our goal is for you and your horse to have a great time without over stressing. We have designed the trail layout with that in mind. Come ride the historic NAN Ranch. Private since 1867, few outsiders have been privileged to ride the ranch. We are grateful to the owners, John and Betty Lang, for the gracious use of their 47,000 acres.

THE FACILITY: Camp will be at the main Ranch headquarters along the spring-fed Mimbres River. The campground is flat and surrounded by tall trees. There will be someone to direct you to the correct parking location. Ride Headquarters, with office, kitchen, bathrooms, showers, Ride Briefing room, and Patio are located at the NAN Ranch Lodge. Swimming pool and hot tub are available for use. The trails are 5100' to 6400' in elevation, and 8 miles of rocky road used at the last ride has been eliminated, replaced with dirt trails in a new area. Expect some rock, river crossings and sighting of cattle, javelina, elk, wild turkeys, antelope, beautiful vistas and quiet glens. 2 faucets for horse water are located in camp and camping fee is \$25/entry.

RULES: Ride is held under current NATRC Rules. Horses crossing state lines need to have Negative Equine Infectious Anemia Test (Coggins) • Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Papers) and hauling papers (proof of ownership). Hauling papers are required for intrastate travel.

SCHEDULE: Leisure Division - Friday 7:30am to 8:00am entries arrive and register at the Ride Office. Group briefing is at 8:30am; the start of the Ride is at 9:30am.

All Other Divisions - arrive Friday morning after 9:30am or may arrive Thursday evening. Rider packets available at Ride Office after 9:30am. Vet Check-in starts at 2:00pm Friday.

AWARDS: To be presented as soon as possible after each Ride is completed.

MEALS: Since individual riders have varied diets and preferences, each is responsible for their own food. Management will transport riders' lunches to Lunch Stops on Saturday. A catered dinner will be served Saturday night for \$12.00 per person.
